POLICY STATEMENT:- "The Friends of M.V. Freedom are committed to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment".

## POLICY AIMS:-

- 1. To co-operate with the RYA/British Marine, Green Blue environmental project and to promote and practice its aims whenever practicable, within Charity Commission Rules.
- 2. To comply with the environmental legislation that relates to the operation of M.V Freedom and where possible identify opportunities to adopt best practice over and above the minimum legislative requirements.
- 3. To ensure the charity manages all potential pollution risks from M.V.Freedom to protect our local waters, including but not limited to, oil, fuel, antifoul, litter and cleaning products.
- 4. To remain alert for the presence of invasive non native species in our local waters.
- 5. To manage all waste generated or collected by MV Freedom through a hierarchy of reduce, reduce, reduce and recycle before responsible disposal.
- 6. To treat all sealife in accordance with the law and best practice and encourage others to do the same.
- 7. To seek to use sustainable practices when organising and running fundraising and social events.
- 8. To publicise our environmental commitment.
- 9. To encourage sustainable best practice amongst our members and boat passengers.
- 10. To consider the environmental credentials of our suppliers when procuring new products, thereby encouraging other organisations to integrate sustainability into their own operations.
- 11. To include environmental awareness and good practice in our crew training regime.
- 12. To measure our progress and review this environmental policy on an annual basis to ensure continual improvement.
